COLLECTIONS POLICY / MISSION STATEMENT

The mission of Holocaust Museum Houston is to promote awareness of the dangers of prejudice, hatred, and violence against the backdrop of the Holocaust. To this end, Holocaust Museum Houston collects, preserves, researches, and exhibits materials relating to pre-World War II Jewish life in Europe, the rise of the Third Reich, the Holocaust and the post-World War II period.

GENERAL OVERVIEW OF COLLECTIONS

Strengths:

The Laurie and Milton Boniuk Library and Archives contains collections on all aspects of Jewish life both before and after the Holocaust, as well as many documents and objects from the Holocaust itself. One of the largest collections is the Meyer Collection, containing the largest collection of concentration camp and ghetto scrip in the world. There is also documentation and photographs from the liberation of the camps and ghettos, and materials from the Nuremberg trials.
